Minutes of the Meeting held on
Wednesday 27th September 2017

Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr Lewis and Cllr Goodrick

The Chairman welcomed Cllr Robert Wainwright and three members of the public to the meeting.

Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 10th July 2017 were agreed and signed, – proposed by Cllr Gibson and seconded by Cllr Blunt – all in favour.

Matters Arising

Trees East End of the Village

The Chairman would contact North Yorkshire re responsibility for the trees.

Defibrillator

A bracket for the defibrillator box has been made by Peter Scaling at no charge to the Council. The Clerk would write to thank him and his staff. Donations have been coming in towards the cost of the electricity and at the present time approximately £1200 has been received.

Speeding

This would be monitored and it may be necessary to contact the traffic police.

Village Hall Sign

It was noted that the sign indicating both Village Hall and parking area is now in place.

Masts

It was noted that the mast had been erected in the Playing Field but the power supply had not been connected. At the present time no satellite dish has been added to the top of the mast.

Footpath in main Street

The footpath near the Plump had been repaired but it was noted that no work could be done to the footpath in front of Terrington Hall School at the present time.

It was also noted that the accumulation of sand on the road at Willow Corner had been removed.

Accounts

It was proposed by Cllr Watson and seconded by Cllr Taylor to pay the following accounts – Village Hall for meeting £20.00. - Robert Goodwill £1800 for grass cutting and it was agreed retrospectively to pay for the Village sign £167.40 – all in favour.

It was proposed by Cllr Blunt and seconded by Cllr Taylor that we should obtain a firm quote from Northern Power for the electricity supply re the defibrillator and pay the full amount from Parish Council funds – all in favour.

The meeting was then opened to the public

Cllr Wainwright gave an interesting account of the situation at Ryedale District Council re it's assets and some different scenarios on how they will go forward.

Pot holes on the road near Willow Corner were reported and the Clerk would inform the Highways.

It was noted the bushes on the road to Coneysthorpe had been cut back but branches were left on the road and on the side verge in large heaps. It had been reported to Castle Howard.

The meeting was closed to the public.

Mr Braithwaite from Darlington asked for permission to place a bench in the village in memory of his son who had lived in the village – all in favour.

Grass cutting

Planning application

Planning application for High Dene Terrington – the parish council agreed that the proposed alterations to the window is not in keeping with the other windows in the house.

Footpath to Little Terrington and the Cemetery

North Yorkshire highways would be contacted re spraying of the footpaths.
