3. To discuss the outcomes from the Public Meeting held on 1st February relating to the RDC Consultation on their Local Plan review. Specifically, the 'feeling of the Meeting' was that the Parish Council should reply to Ryedale stating the opposition by residents of Terrington to the village being designated as a Service Village.

Proposal: That Council sends the views expressed by the public to Ryedale DC in email letter form.

4. Council has previously approved moving forward with the concept of a Neighbourhood Plan for Terrington. The recent Public Meeting produced a list of persons who may be or who are interested in forming a Plan group. This would need to be , in order to be able to gain permission and to submit the plan, a committee of this Council, with at least one Councillor member.

Proposal: 1)That Council organises a group meeting in this room, later in February, suggested dates 21st or 22nd Feb and attempts at that meeting to form a Committee to be the Terrington Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group.

2) That the Committee if formed is able to co-opt members of the public onto the committee by virtue of their specialist interest in this matter.

5. To approve expenditure of £7.20 for the hire of the Wimbush room for this Extraordinary Parish Council meeting on 08-02-2023 and for £12.00 for the hire of the Wimbush Room for a meeting of the PC Committee, 'Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group' in February 2023.
