### 4. Finance

**4.1** To note the following receipt since the last Parish Council meeting on 08-07-2024: Neighbourhood Planning Grant of £4595.00 from Groundwork UK to finance activities taking place during the period 31/07/2024 to 31/03/2025 with unspent funds to be returned to Groundwork UK.

**4.2** To note the following payments against approved expenditure since the last Parish Council meeting on 08-07-2024:

£7.20 to Terrington Village Hall for hire of the Wimbush Room for the Extraordinary Parish Council meeting on 22-05-24 (authorisation: 11-03-24 Minute 4.11.5).

£39.00 for timber for repairs to railings in Stores Lane and £5.37 including £0.90 VAT for bin labels to Cllr Winning (authorisation: 08-07-24 Minute 4.4).

**4.3** To receive a statement of payments and receipts in the current financial year to date by budget heading (attached).

**4.4** To approve setting up an Earmarked Reserve of £4595.00 to fund activities specified in the Neighbourhood Planning Offer of Grant.

**4.5** To authorise expenditure from the Neighbourhood Planning Earmarked Reserve for activities taking place by 31/03/2025 under the following budget headings up to the sums specified in the Neighbourhood Planning Offer of Grant, as follows

NP2/4 £300 Post submission

**4.6** To authorise expenditure of £220 on printing flyers and posters for Neighbourhood Plan Reg14, this being more than the total agreed by the Chairman and Clerk on 28-08-24 because of higher quality paper being used, and to allocate this expenditure to budget heading NP2/7: Materials for Reg 14 consultation.

## 5. Terrington Parish Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan Group has produced a Draft Neighbourhood Plan and Design Codes and Guidance. The Council is asked to note that any comments it may wish to make on the Draft Neighbourhood Plan can be included as part of the Reg 14 consultation.

The Design Codes and Guidance, which is a finalised document, is provided as part of the consultation process.
