4. Informal Consultation – Revised Diversion application, The Pheantry, Terrington, RYE/2020/21/PROP

The Parish Council, as a statutory consultee, is asked to consider its response to an informal consultation on a revised proposal to divert Public Footpath 25.94/11. The Parish Council is asked by North Yorkshire Council (the Authority) if it has any objections to the proposal.

The Parish Council is reminded that Diversion Orders must satisfy the relevant legal tests under **Section 119** of the Highways Act 1980. Before making, and subsequently confirming, a diversion order the Authority must be satisfied that:

- it is expedient to divert the path in the interests either of the public or the owner of the land crossed by the path.
- the proposed diversion does not alter any point of termination of the path, other than to another point on the same path, or to another highway connected with it, and which is substantially as convenient to the public.
- it is expedient to divert the path in the interests of the person(s) stated in the order.
- the route will not be substantially less convenient to the public as a consequence of the diversion
- it is expedient to confirm the Diversion Order having regard to the effect it will have on public enjoyment of the path as a whole, on other land served by the existing path and on land affected by any new path.

The Council, having been provided with details and a map of the proposed diversion is asked to consider whether the relevant legal tests are satisfied and determine whether it has any objections.

Motion: It is proposed that all the relevant legal tests for the Diversion are met and that the Council has no objections to the diversion application. (Proposer Cllr Winning).

5. **Planning Application** ZE24/06408/CAT Fell Leylandii tree and remove stump, replant 2-3 fruit trees at Appleyard Cottage, Terrington.

The Council has until the 31 October if it wishes to comment on the application.
