Minutes of an extraordinary meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 3 April 2023 at 7:00pm in Terrington Village Hall

1. Attendance and apologies.

Present - Cllr Winning (Chairman), Cllr Adkins, Cllr Challoner Walker, Cllr Kendrick, Cllr Lewis, Cllr Stevenson.

2. Declarations of interest.

3. To consider the Planning Application 13/00249/FUL – Cotril Farm, New Road, Terrington, YO60 6NT Change of use of agricultural land to a seasonal camping site to allow 24no. tent and 6no. motor home pitches to include erection of an associated toilet block.

The Chairman reminded Councillors that this is a new application, not an alteration to a previous application. In summary, this application is for a smaller scale campsite with a timber framed clad toilet block and additional hedgerow screening, operating from May to October. Access is via a single-track road and it is proposed that a passing place be constructed to the east of New Road, south of the site.

The Council heard various views expressed concerning the visual appearance of a campsite in an AONB and the issues with traffic generation and the efforts that the applicants have made to address concerns relating to the previous campsite. In considering the application, Councillors recognised the importance of respecting and protecting the character of the countryside, potential disruptions to local residents, but also the need to balance it with sustainable rural tourism and the diversification of agriculture.

Councillors were asked whether they supported the application. 4 Councillors supported the application and 2 abstained. In line with the majority vote, the Parish Council confirmed that it has no objection to the application.

4. To hear an update on the Neighbourhood Area Designation application.

The Clerk reported that the Planning Department has acknowledged receipt of the Terrington Parish Council's Neighbourhood Area designation application

submitted on 23 March 2023. The Planning Officer is checking the application to ensure that it contains everything required to progress the Plan. The next stage will be to get, from the relevant NYC Committee, a resolution to consult on the Neighbourhood Plan area.

5. To discuss litter picking in and around Terrington.

The Chairman expressed his grateful thanks to those residents who frequently and without being asked, give their time to collect litter in and around the village.

He suggested that a day should be set when there would be a concerted effort in litter picking in and around Terrington. The date set is **15 April 2023**.
