**Minutes of the meeting on May 14<sup>th</sup> 2018**

It was proposed by Cllr Lewis and seconded by Cllr Watson that the minutes of the meeting were agreed and signed – all in favour

**Chairman's report**

The Chairman thanked Cllr Goodrick and Cllr Wainwright for their support during the year. Cllr Blunt was thanked for his excellent management of the finances and it was with regret that his retirement from the Council was noted. The Chairman also thanked the Clerk for her work over the year. He also thanked the members of the public who had assisted the Council over the year, in particular Mark Wigham for his help during the year.

**Clerk's Report**

The Clerk gave her report of work done during the year and expressed her thanks to the Chairman for his assistance and to all members of the Parish Council for their attendance at the meetings.

**Clerk of the Burial Board Report.**

The receipts for 2018/19 amounted to £1600.00. The Clerk informed the meeting that the large amount of receipts was partly due to several of the deceased living outside the parish, but who have family connections and therefore were entitled to be buried in the cemetery but were charged double fees.

The Council had a working party earlier in the year which was a success.

**Treasurer's Report**

The Treasurer Cllr Blunt gave a comprehensive report on the finances of the Council. The income for the year was £5892.12 and expenditure £5937.01. The total carried forward to 2019/20 is £4751.93.42 It was proposed by Cllr Winning and seconded by Cllr Watson that these accounts should be accepted subject to Audit - all in favour

The Chairman then introduced Mr James Hoy Chief Executive Officer at Castle Howard who gave an interesting insight into the problems the Estate were having regarding finance and informed the meeting of the many events they were holding during the coming year. He indicated that he would like to address the Parish Council later in the year when the Estate were more informed on their future plans
